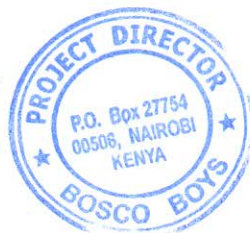
I am so very happy to have come in contact with Dr. Alfons and Mayor Achim, both of whom have come to Kenya, Kakuma along with one or two others. Dr. Alfons in November 2018 visited the slums of Nairobi, namely Kibera, Mathare, and Pangani-Chai Road where the mother of Stephen Kagoiyo, a boy born in the street and through Bosco Boys made it to be Mechanic and driver and care giver for street boys at Bosco Boys. Now he is attending classes in counseling. I am sure Dr. Alfons keeps you informed of his findings and all our communication. Thank you and thank you Dr. Alfons for this.

This year we are in the process of bringing about 50 boys from the street for rehabilitation. 22 of them have finished rehabilitation and have joined Bosco Boys Primary school. We have a total of 457 students under our care. 68 Of them in the two Nurseries in the slums, 234 in the Bosco Boys Primary, 94 in the secondary schools, 8 doing technical and 18 in the Universities. 32 just completed Class 8 and are joining Secondary school in 2019. Without your help we are helpless and God has given us this gift of you to Bosco Boys.
